Page 53 footnote cv *for* Art Kavanagh was godparent to Nicholas Forrestal *read* Art Kavanagh, a New Ross merchant who held lands at Turra, St Mullins, Co. Carlow and was son of Michael Kavanagh Sr. of Ballynacoolagh, Ballyleigh, Co. Wexford was godfather to Nicholas Forrestal.

Page 54 footnote cvi *for* Gerald's son Charles Kavanagh was the father of Catherine, mother to Art Kavanagh of Coolnemara *read* Gerald's son Charles Kavanagh was the godfather of Catherine, sister of Art Kavanagh of Coolnemara.

Page 61 footnote cxxvii *for* Patrick, Pierce, and Richard Strange were the stepsons of Dr. John Forstall *read* Patrick, Pierce, and Richard Strange were the sons of Laurence Strange.
